

Executive Council Resolution No. (6) of 2014
Forming the
Committee for Management of the Health Insurance of the
Government of Dubai Employees¹

We, Hamdan bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Crown Prince of Dubai, Chairman of the Executive Council,

After perusal of:

Law No. (3) of 2003 Establishing the Executive Council of the Emirate of Dubai;

Law No. (27) of 2006 Concerning Management of the Government of Dubai Human Resources and its amendments;

Law No. (31) of 2009 Establishing the Dubai Government Human Resources Department; and
Executive Council Resolution No. (16) of 2013 Concerning Health Insurance of the Government of Dubai Employees,

Do hereby issue this Resolution.

Formation of the Committee
Article (1)

Pursuant to this Resolution, a committee named the "Committee for Management of the Health Insurance of the Government of Dubai Employees" (the "**Committee**") is formed under the chairmanship of the Director General of the Dubai Government Human Resources Department. The Committee will be comprised of the following members:

1. a representative from the Department of Finance, as vice chairman;
2. a representative from the Dubai Health Authority, as member;
3. a representative from the Government of Dubai Legal Affairs Department, as member; and
4. a representative from the Dubai Government Human Resources Department, as member.

Executive Council Resolution No. (6) of 2014 Forming the Committee for Management of the Health Insurance of the Government of Dubai Employees

Nomination of Representatives of Entities
Article (2)

Representatives from the entities referred to in Article (1) of this Resolution will be nominated by the officials in charge of these entities.

Functions of the Committee
Article (3)

The Committee will have for the duties and powers to:

1. consider applications for joining the health insurance scheme submitted to it by any entity, and submit appropriate recommendations to the Director General of the Department of Finance for approval;
2. issue the required health insurance resolutions;
3. determine grievances filed with it by the Health Insurance Claims Management Company, Healthcare Providers, and Employees; and
4. strike off permanently or suspend any Healthcare Provider from the Health Insurance Network based on a technical report issued by the Dubai Health Authority.

Powers of the Committee
Article (4)

In performing its duties and exercising its powers under this Resolution, the Committee may:

1. seek assistance from experts and specialists as its deems appropriate; and
2. form and determine the duties of sub-committees and specialised work teams.

Meetings and Resolutions of the Committee
Article (5)

- a. The Committee will be convened by its chairman, or in his absence by its vice chairman, at least once every three (3) months, or where required. Meetings of the Committee will be valid if attended by the majority of its members, provided that the chairman or vice chairman is in attendance.
- b. The Committee will issue its resolutions by majority vote of its attending members, and in the event of a tie, the chair of the meeting will have the casting vote. The resolutions of the Committee will be recorded in minutes signed by the chair of the meeting and attending members.

Rapporteur of the Committee
Article (6)

The Committee will have a rapporteur selected by the chairman. The rapporteur will be tasked with coordinating the meetings of the Committee, preparing its agenda, recording its minutes of meetings, following up its resolutions and recommendations, following up the work of its sub-committees and work teams, and performing any other duties assigned to him by the chairman of the Committee.

Commencement and Publication
Article (7)

This Resolution comes into force on the day on which it is issued, and will be published in the Official Gazette.
